



**SELECTION CRITERIA**

- Demonstrate contributions to independent as well as collaborative research with evidence of impact in quality use of medicines.
- Demonstrate experience in successfully leading multidisciplinary research teams at national and international levels and working collaboratively with the broader health sector and other key stakeholders.
- Demonstrate an outstanding publication record in high-quality (ERA recognised) international journals successfully applied for nationally competitive research funding or major consultancies.
- Demonstrate significant experience in capacity building, supervising and mentoring early career researchers and research students.
- Demonstrate strong commitment to teaching and development of education programs within the broad areas of pharmacy and the Charles Perkins Centre, including but not limited to pharmacotherapeutics, chronic disease state prevention/management, medication management, quality use of medicines, epidemiology and pharmaceutical policy in both undergraduate and postgraduate professional pharmacy courses (Bachelor of Pharmacy and Master of Pharmacy) and research degrees (Master of Philosophy and Doctor of Philosophy).
- Demonstrate the ability to embrace cultural change and to embody a collaborative and cooperative ethos in all aspects of academic life.
