

SELECTION CRITERIA

LECTURER IN ACCOUNTING

Academic Level B

Essential:

FORMAL QUALIFICATIONS

- Completion of a PhD in Accounting or a related discipline

TEACHING EXPERIENCE

- Evidence of high quality teaching at both undergraduate and postgraduate level, and of capacity to contribute to course and program development.

RESEARCH ABILITY

- Demonstrated ability to achieve research outcomes and publish in high quality international refereed publications.

EVIDENCE OF RESEARCH POTENTIAL

- An active research program with significant potential for future publication.

EXPERTISE IN A SPECIALISED FIELD

- Expertise in one or more of the major area of accounting, including financial accounting and/or audit.

EVIDENCE OF ABILITY TO WORK CO-OPERATIVELY WITH OTHERS

- Evidence of successful teamwork and a collegial approach.

ENGAGEMENT WITH INDUSTRY AND PROFESSIONAL BODIES

- Evidence of commitment to the School's engagement with industry and professional bodies in order to develop innovative teaching programs and expand its program of professional and industry research collaboration.

Desirable:

FORMAL QUALIFICATIONS

- A professional accounting qualification

INDUSTRIAL / PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

- Experience in industry and / or the profession and membership of a recognised professional association.
