A PhD in business information systems or a related field (completed or under examination)

### **TEACHING EXPERIENCE**

- Evidence of, or potential to perform high quality teaching at both undergraduate and postgraduate level
- Demonstrated ability to achieve teaching and learning outcomes

### PROVEN RESEARCH ABILITY AND POTENTIAL FOR FUTURE DEVELOPMENT

- Previous research experience
- Demonstrated ability to achieve research outcomes with refereed publications
- · Potential for future publication in quality journals

### PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE AND EXPERTISE

- Expertise in one or more of the key areas of business information systems, in particular: Business Analysis; Enterprise Social Media; Enterprise Systems; Information & Organisation; Project Management
- A demonstrated IS theoretical and methodological background, and familiarity with interpretivist, qualitative research approaches

## **EVIDENCE OF ABILITY TO WORK CO-OPERATIVELY WITH OTHERS**

 Collegial approach to work and team work; good interpersonal skills; demonstrated assistance of students of all levels of ability and of all backgrounds
