FORMAL QUALIFICATIONS

A PhD in business information systems or a related field

TEACHING EXPERIENCE

- Proven record of high quality teaching with substantial experience, at both undergraduate and postgraduate level and a successful record of honours and postgraduate supervision
- Significant contributions to course and program development

PROVEN RESEARCH ABILITY

- · Active research program.
- Established research record including a significant number of publications in high quality refereed international journals.
- Potential for future publication in high quality journals.
- Demonstrated ability to achieve research outcomes with refereed publications.
- Proven record of ability to attract research funding.

ADMINISTRATIVE EXPERIENCE

 Administrative experience including course administration; commitment and service to the University, discipline and profession

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE AND EXPERTISE

- Expertise in one or more of the key areas of business information systems, in particular: Business Analysis; Enterprise Social Media; Enterprise Systems; Information & Organisation; Project Management
- Strong demonstrated IS theoretical and methodological background, in particular in interpretivist, qualitative research approaches
- A record of industry and professional involvement and collaboration
