- International reputation and track record for academic research, publication and successful external grant applications in architecture; engagement with universities, museums, and arts organisations within or outside of Australia **OR**
- International reputation for critical, reflective design practice together with relevant creative research output and experience in tertiary education
- Demonstrable capacity to initiate and drive collaborative cross-disciplinary research, teaching and engagement
- Evidence of ability to attract and supervise higher degree research students and postdoctoral candidates
- Evidence of ability to envision new directions of research to anticipate changes in the field of architecture
- Demonstrated teaching ability at tertiary level
- Experience in academic leadership and management
- Demonstrated experience in curriculum development and reform

DESIRABLE CRITERIA

- Experience in leadership of curriculum development
- Demonstrable teaching excellence in the key discipline areas of design, technology, communications or professional practice
