POSITION DESCRIPTION: NON RESIDENTIAL TEACHING FELLOWS

These casual positions involve the following objectives and duties.

Objectives

To contribute to the intellectual life and the academic profile of the College by taking a leadership role in tutoring, academic mentoring and involvement in the Senior Common Room.

Duties

- Provide regular tutorials (usually two per week) for College students that address the students' learning needs
- Assist with the College's academic mentoring program with a focus on high achievers
- Contribute to the Senior Common Room Program through regular attendance at Senior Common Room functions and the provision of one to two seminar papers or presentations during the tenure of appointment
- Build effective networks between the College and University Faculties and Schools as appropriate

Remuneration

- Each Fellow will be paid \$4200 per year.

- Experience in providing tutorials to University students.
