LECTURER IN LINGUISTICS (PHONETICS AND PHONOLOGY)

ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

- PhD in Linguistics
- Ability to teach widely across the linguistics curriculum, in undergraduate and postgraduate programs
- Ability to teach phonetics and phonology
- A demonstrated research track record in an area of typologically oriented linguistics
- Expertise in phonetic/phonological research, possibly as part of broader program
- Ability to articulate a plausible and ambitious 3-year research plan
- Expertise in up-to-date phonetic/phonological theory and methods, possibly as part of broader program
- Evidence of capacity for efficiency and responsibility in general academic administrative tasks
- Ability to work in a collegial and effective manner with colleagues in Department, Faculty, and University
- Fluent written and spoken English
- Evidence of positive and constructive attitude toward diverse approaches to language within the discipline and across disciplines

DESIRABLE CRITERIA

- Teaching experience at tertiary level in linguistics
- Evidence of capacity to manage collaborative research projects
- Research focus on a non Indo-European language or languages
- Expertise in statistical and/or digital methods for linguistics
- Experience with diverse student body, including local, career change and international students
- Experience supervising research students
- Experience in collaborative work across linguistic sub-disciplines and/or different disciplines
