ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

- 1. Strong analytical background with a social and organisational research agenda
- 2. Experience of strong research training
- 3. A record of publication in competitive journals and conference proceedings
- 4. Evidence of a record of proposals for competitive research grant schemes which were either successful or ranked highly
- 5. Lecturing experience at tertiary level, with demonstrated high quality
- 6. Experience in supervising research students
- 7. Excellent communication skills
- 8. Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively, as well as the ability to develop an independent line of research
- 9. Clear potential for appointment or promotion to higher level academic positions

ESSENTIAL CRITERIA FOR LEVEL C (IN ADDITION TO LEVEL B CRITERIA)

- 1. An outstanding record of research achievement demonstrated by publications in the top international venues and evidence of obtaining competitive research funding
- 2. Proven ability to develop industry and community engagement
- 3. Strong evidence of teaching excellence, and ability to prepare new teaching material and develop new units of study
- 4. Evidence of supervising (or being part of a supervisory team) research students
