ESSENTIAL MINIMUM CRITERIA

- 1 PhD in a relevant field (e.g. flavour chemistry, or sensory and consumer science) with demonstrated experience in food or beverage sensory evaluation
- 2 Evidence of strong independent research activity and demonstrated peer reviewed publication record
- 3 Demonstrated knowledge and experience with multivariate sensory statistics and complex datasets
- 4 Excellent written and oral communication skills with the ability to liaise, collaborate and interact with representatives from industry and academia
- 5 Ability to work effectively as a member of a research team, and independently when required
- 6 Capacity to meet deadlines and complete manuscripts in a timely manner
- 7 Ability to use initiative to solve problems in non-routine situations
- 8 Current drivers licence and a willingness to work in the field when required

DESIRABLE CHARACTERISTICS

- 1 Previous postdoctoral experience
- 2 Ability to facilitate sensory panels and coordinate consumer trials
- 3 Understanding of wine chemistry and aroma/flavour
- 4 Interest in the food and beverage industry
- 5 Experience with supervising technical staff and/or students
