Instructions:

Welcome to the second stage in applying to the TOSST Research School. To be considered an applicant of this program, further information is required from the student and the nominating supervisor.

Admission to the TOSST research school is highly competitive and nominations should only be put forward if the student meets a minimum standard of quality, i.e., A- in the last two years, or if the student, under exceptional circumstances, can confirm alternative qualifications and justification for acceptance.

At this stage, all students must have already spoken to a supervisor, in the appropriate Dalhousie department. The supervisor must now proceed with nominating the student as an official TOSST applicant.

This nomination form is completed in two parts, **Part A**, and **Part B**. Part A of this form is to be completed electronically by the student candidate and forwarded to the research supervisor. Part B is to be completed electronically by the nominating supervisor.

When the two parts are completed, the supervisor then forwards the completed nomination form, along with an electronic copy of the nominee's full application file, plus any additional documents required to fulfill the TOSST requirements for admission, to the TOSST graduate committee for consideration of acceptance into the TOSST program. Send all application materials, in one email, to tost@dal.ca, with the subject line, 'TOSST PhD Fellowship Opportunity', or for a Master's application, 'TOSST MSc Fellowship Opportunity'.
