- 8 Ability to work in a multidisciplinary team environment.

- 1 Research interest in one or more of the research strengths of the Discipline.
- 2 Proven ability to teach gross anatomy, neuroanatomy, embryology, histology and pathophysiology.
- 3 International recognition of achievement in biomedical sciences and the scholarship of teaching and learning.
