ESSENTIAL MINIMUM CRITERIA

- 1 Higher degree, preferably at doctorate level or equivalent in veterinary clinical pathology, or a related discipline.
- 2 Advanced training in veterinary pathology, with eligibility for specialist certification (ACVP, ESVP, MANZCVS, FRCPath, or equivalent)
- 2 Evidence of contributions to the teaching of veterinary clinical pathology at the tertiary level
- 3 Experience in the provision of diagnostic service in veterinary clinical pathology
- 4 Strong interpersonal skills and demonstrated ability to work collaboratively as a member of teaching and research teams.
- 5 Qualification in Veterinary Science acceptable for registration in South Australia.

DESIRABLE CHARACTERISTICS

- 1 Specialist qualifications in clinical pathology (ACVP, ESVP, MANZCVS, FRCPath, or equivalent).
- 2 A record of research based publication and evidence of the ability to attract research funding
- 3 Experience with the supervision of major honours or postgraduate research projects.
